The Shariff open said Court by proclamation.

In the Matter Approving Minutes of Feb, Mar and March, Special Term.

After reading of the Minutes of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, at its February and March regular and March Special Terms, by the County Clerk, a motion was made by Commissioner Old and seconded by King that the minutes be approved the County Judge put the motion before the members of said emmassioners Court with the request that as many as favored said said motion to vote "Aye" and thoses oppose to vote "We" all of said commissioner voted "Aye" being no votes east for "Re" The County Judge minimize declared the motion carried and the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter changing Voting Box, No.5. Maple Springs. Veting Box. 9. (Line)

April, 11th, A.D., 1921.

Thereas citizins: ef precinct No. 3 have appeared before the Coumissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, showing cause why the line between voting box No. 5 and Poting box No. 9 should be changed for the better accommandation of the unjority of the citizins of voting precinct -No. 5. and Commissioner King made motion and seconded by commissioner Old that the line between voting box No 5 and voting Nox No. 9 be changed.

It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the Court that the line between the two voting bexes be changed from it's present cité to a line running due North and South from White Oak Creek to Sulphur Creek, intersecting the graded Road at branch 250 yards 8.2. of Bud Graf's present residence, . It is further ordered that place of voting in precinet shall hereafter be at Marris Chapal instead of Mayles Springs, in voting box No. 5.

In the Matter of allowing Accounts.

Notice by Commissioner Old and seconded by Commissioner King that the accounts be allowed as entered in Yel 2 and page 78 and 79 as entered in Himstee of accounts allowed, the County Judge put the motion because the members for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to "Aye" and those opposed to vote THe" all of said members voted "Aye", being no votes east for "Ne" the County Judge declaried the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of Flumbing at Court House and Jail.

In the matter of allowing Shariff for Boarding of Prianara

Thereas, at the February Term, 1921, of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, there was an order as entered whereby allewing the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas, the sum of 75 cents per day for boarding prisoners each, and on this day Commissioner Flemings made a motion and seconded by Commissioner Edwards, that said order be rescinded and that the Sheriff be allowed the sum of 60 cents per day for boarding each prisoner for indefinits time and to be changed at the option of the Commissioners Court and said allowance shall begin on the 1st day of April, A.D.,1921. The County Judge put the metion for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to Raye" and thoses opposed to vote "No" Commissioners Floming, Edwards, Old and King, all voted "Aye" The County Judge deblared the motion carried and order massed.
