Special May, 4th, 1921.

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON THIS DAY THERE WAS BEGUN AND HOLDENED A SPECIAL TERM OF COMMISSIONER COURT, at the Court House in the City of Mount Pleasant, Texas, with the following officers present to wit; Dan M. Cook, County Judge, W.M.King, W.M.Edwards, L.H.Old and V.A.Fleming, Commissioners, and Ulman Brown, County Clerk. when the following proceeding were had to wit; Court was open by proclamation by the Sheriff, John J.Reeves.

County Commissioner,Old,offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that same be passed by the Court, which motion was seconded by Commissioner,Edwards, the order is as follows, to wit; that this Court appoint the following named persons as Road Commissioners for said County to serve with the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas in the matter of the expenditure of the proceeds of a \$1,000,000.00, bond issue, to wit; Ed.L.McElroy for Justice Precinct No. 1. C.W.Fleming for Justice Precinct No.2, J.V.Barrett for Justice Precinct No. 3, J.W. Covey for Justice Precinct No. 4, D.Warner for Justice Precinct No. 5, H.L.Traylor for Justice Precinct No. 7, A.D.Miller for Justice Precinct No. 8 and W.A.Lee for Justice Precinct No. 9.. It is therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that each and all of said persons as above named be and they are appointed Road Commissioners for Titus County, Texas, as provided and required by the special Road law now in force for Titus County, Texas. The County Judge put the motion before the said commissioners Court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Edwards, Old and Fleming Voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
