BE IT REMEMBERED That there was begun and holden a Special Term of Commissioner Court in and for Titus County, Texas, on this day June 1st. 1921, with the following officers present to-wit; Hon Dan M. Cook, County Judge, W.M.King, W.M.Edwards, W.A.Fleming and L.N.Old, County Commissioners, and Ulman Brown, County County Clerk, when the following proceedings were had to wit;

Court was open up by proclamation by the Sheriff.

In the Matter of approving #  
Road Commissioners Bonds # June 1st. 1921.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of approving the bonds of the Road Commissioners of Titus County, Texas, when Commissioner Old made a motion to approve the following bonds to wit: W.A.Lee, J.V.Covey, J.W.Barrett, C.W.Fleming, H.L.Traylor, D.Warner and A.C.Miller, as Members of the Permanent Road Commissioners of Titus, Texas, seconded by Commissioner W.M.King, The County County, Judge put the motion before the court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "N<sup>O</sup>" Commissioner Edwards, Fleming, Old and King, all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of approving #  
C.Y.Parson's Bond, as Surveyor # June 1st. 1921.

Motion by Commissioner Edwards and seconded by Commissioner Old that the Bond of C.Y.Parson, as County Surveyor, of Titus County, Texas, be approved. The County Judge Put the motion before the court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Fleming, Old and Edwards all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of appointing #  
Road Commissioner Pre. One, # June 1st. 1921.

County Commissioner W.M.Edwards, offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that same be passed by the Court, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Fleming, the order is as follows, to wit; that this Court appoint John B. Stephens, as Road Commissioner for Precinct No. One, Titus County, Texas, to serve with the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas in the matter of the expenditure of the proceeds of a \$1,000,000.00, bond issue. It is therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the said John B.Stephens, is appointed Road Commissioner of Titus County, Texas, The County Judge put the motion before the said Commissioners Court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King Edwards, Fleming and Old all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of approving #  
the Annual Report of Tax Collector. # June 1st. 1921.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, the Annual Report of Herbert L. Smith, Tax Collector of Titus County, Texas, when Commissioner Fleming made a motion, which motion was seconded by Commissioner King; that

the Annual Report of said Herbert L. Smith be in all things approved. The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "Aye" and all those opposed to vote "No" Commissioner King, Fleming, Old, and Edwards voted "Aye" none voted "No". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
