It appears to the Commissioner Court of Titus County, Texas that it is necessary to transfer the sum of \$5,059.49, from State Highway to Special Road Fund, and the sum of \$5,000.00, from State Highway to Special Road for Emergency claims, and the sum of \$11,332.86, from State Highway to Special Road, The County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Edwards, Fleming and Old all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
