Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas.

On this the 27th day of June 1921, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas met as a Board of Equalization to check over the rendition sheets of the Tax Assessor of Titus County and remained in session for six days.

In the matter of Allowing Sheriff #

On this day came on to be heard by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of allowing John J. Reeves, Sheriff, 60 cents per day for boarding prisoners each, when Commissioner Edwards made a motion and seconded by Commissioner King that the order passed at the June Term of the Commissioners Court, whereby allowing the Sheriff the sum of 75 cents per day for boarding each prisoner be rescinded and that hereafter beginning on July 1st, 1921, the Sheriff be allowed the sum of 60 cents per day for the boarding each prisoner, The County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Old, Fleming and Edwards all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, a Superintendent of the Highways of Titus County, Texas, it appearing that J.B. Garrett has been discharged as Superintendent of Highways of Titus County, Texas, and Commissioner Edwards made a motion and seconded by Commissioner Old that A.R. Avery be appointed as Superintendent of Roads known as Highways in Titus County, Texas, beginning July 1st, 1921, and to be paid the sum of \$100.00, per month on the first day of each month out of the State Highway Auto Fund for said service, and that said A.R. Avery as Superintendent of Highways shall employ all necessary labor with the approval of this Court for the up keep and maintaining of the Highways of Titus County, Texas, The County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner Edwards, Old and Fleming voted "Aye" Commissioner King voted "No", The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

Said Report after having been examined by the Court and after having been found to be according to contract, the same is approved by the Court and ordered filed.

After having examined said report and the Court having ascertained a number of shortages due Titus County by officials and County Depositories, It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the Court that the County Clerk notify each and all officials found by said report to be in arrears, and to notify all County Depositories and their bondsmen to to make an immediate settlement at once according to the said report of said Auditors this day approved of all arrears with said Titus County, and that Allen Reed proceed as County Attorney for Titus County, Texas, to collect all shortages and arrears of County Officials and County Depositories as shown by the report filed this day and approved by this Court ordered adjudged and decreed in open Court this the 27th day of June, A.D. 1921, and it is further ordered by the Court to allow the sum of \$250.00, to Dewitt and Pickett, for extra auditing beginning Dec. 1, 1920 and ending April 1st, 1921 County Records of Titus County, Texas.
