On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioner Court of Titus County, Texas, a Superintendent of the Highways of Titus County, Texas, it appearing that J.B.Garrett has been discharged as Superintendent of Highways of Titus County, Texas, and Commissioner Edwards made a motion and seconded by Commissioner Old that A.R.Avery be appointed as Superintendent of Roads known as Highways in Titus County, Texas, beginning July 1st. 1921, and to be paid the the aum of \$100.00, per menth on the first day of each month out of the State Highway Auto Fund for said service, and that said A.R.Avery as Superintendent of Highways shall employ all necessary labor with the approvel of this Court for the up keep and maintaining of the Highways of Titus County, Texas, The County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "NO" Commissioner Edwards, Old and Fleming voted "Aye" Commissioner King voted "No", The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the matter of allowing Accounts.

Motion by Commissioner King and seconded by Commissioner Old that the accounts be allowed and that the County Clerk, issue warrants for same as same entered in Vol. 2, minutes of accounts allowed page 88. The County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Old, Flewing and Edwards all voted "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried that the order passed.
