BE IT REMEMBERED that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, met at the Court House of said County in Special Term, on the 7th day of September, A.D., 1921, with the following members present, to wit; County Judge, Dan M. Cook, County Commissioners, W.M. Edwards, V.A. Fleming, W.M. King, and L.R. Old, and County Clerk, Ulman Brown.

County Commissioner, W.M. Edwards, offered the following order to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that same be passed by the Court, which motion was seconded by County Commissioner L.R. Old, the order is as follows, to wit:

It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that it is necessary to provide the funds to complete Highway No. 35 and to make contract for the labor and material to accomplish such purpose.

It is, therefore, ordered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that the County Judge of Titus County advertise as required by law for bids of offers to furnish the labor and material to complete the construction of said Road and bridges thereon to be made to this Court on October 10th, A.D., 1921, such work and material will be approximately in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars and will be payable in annual installments in a period of 15 years bearing 7% interest.

The County Judge put the motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the request that as many as favored the motion would vote "Aye" and all opposed to vote "No" County Commissioners Edwards, Fleming, King and Old voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

The foregoing minutes read and approved this September, 7th, A.D., 1921.
