

SEPTEMBER REGULAR TERM COMMISSIONER COURT:

SEPTEMBER 12th, 1921.

BE IT REMEMBERED That there was begun and holden a regular Term of the Honorable Commissioners Court on this the 12th, day of September, A.D., 1921, at the Court House in the City of Mount Pleasant, Texas, with the following officers present to wit, Hon. Dan M. Cook, County Judge, Commissioners, W.A.Fleming, W.M.Edwards, W.M.King and L.N. Old, and Ulman Brown, County Clerk, when the following proceeding were had to wit; Court open up by proclamation by the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING ACCOUNT.

Commissioner King made a motion and seconded by Commissioner Edwards, that the accounts be allowed as the same appears in the Minutes of Accounts Allowed Vol. 2, pages 96,97 and 98, The County County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner Old, King, Edwards and Fleming all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of Approving Officers Reports. Sept. 12th, 1921.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of approving Officers Reports, when Commissioner Old made a motion to approve said reports, John Reeves, Sheriff, G.B.Dickson, County Treasurer, Herbert L. Smith, Tax Collector, motion seconded by Commissioner King, The County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioners King, Fleming, Old and Edwards, all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and in all things said reports approved.

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING Clayton D.Browne, FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT ROAD. Sept. 12th, 1921.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of allowing Clayton D.Browne, funds to construct road known as the Pat Harris Graded Road, about 4 miles on to East end of said road to the Titus County, line, when Commissioner King made a motion to allow the sum of \$875.00, out of the Road & Bridge Fund, and to be issued in Three Warrants with interest added from this date at the rate of 8 per cent, per annum, first warrant for the sum of \$302.35, due March 1st, 1922, and second warrant for the sum of \$286.56, due March 1st, 1923, and third warrant, for the sum of \$286.09, due March, 1st, 1924, The County Judge put the the motion before said members of said court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioners King, Edwards, Fleming and Old all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
