

SPECIAL TERM OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT

SEPTEMBER 29TH 1921.

Be it remembered that on this the 29th day of September 1921, there was begun and holden a Special Term of the Commissioners Court in and for Titus County, Texas, at the Court House in the City of Mount Pleasant, Texas, with the following officers present to-wit; Hon Dan M. Cook, County Judge, Commissioners. W.A. Flaming, W.W. Edwards and L.H. Old and Ulman Brown, County Clerk. when the following proceedings were had to wit:

Court open up by proclamation by the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas.

Resolution passed by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, on the 29th day of September, 1921.

WHEREAS, the Texarkana Gravel Company of Texarkana, Texas, under date September 28th, 1920, executed its bond with the United States Fidelity & Guaranty Company as survey in the sum of Forty Thousand (\$40,000.00) Dollars payable to the Road Commissioners of Titus County, Texas, covering a loan by said Commissioners to said Gravel Company in the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars, as well as the delivery of certain gravel as per contract entered into by and between said Texarkana Gravel Company and said Road Commissioners of Titus County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, said Texarkana Gravel Company has repaid the said sum of \$25,000.00 and completed the delivery of the gravel called for in said contract on May 19th, 1921; therefore be it resolved by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County in Special Session that said bond aforesaid be and the same is hereby released as of May 19th, 1921,

And said Commissioner's Court hereby further certifies that there is now no liability on said bond and has not been since said May 19th, 1921.
