

Be it remembered that the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas met in a special session thereof at the Court House of said County, on the 21st day of October A.D. 1921, with the following members present, to-wit:

D.M. Cook, County Judge, Edwards, Fleming, King and Olds, County Commissioners and Ulman Brown, Clerk.

County Commissioner, Edwards, offered the following order to the Commissioners Court to Titus County, Texas, and made a motion that the same be passed by the Court which motion was seconded by County Commissioner, King. The order in word and figures is as follows, to-wit:

"It appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, that heretofore on the 10th day of October, A.D. 1921 Titus County, Texas and Smith Brothers, a partnership composed of A.F. Smith and J.H. Smith, of Crockett, Texas, entered into a contract by the terms of which Smith Brothers agreed and became obligated, to furnish to Titus County, Texas, the labor and material for the completion of roads and bridges in said County: That the Engineer, in the employ of said County has furnished this Court an estimate of the said labor and material, which under the terms of said contract is the account of Smith Brothers to said County for such labor and material, which has been filed with the Clerk of this court and that said estimate of said labor and material is in word and figures as follows, to-wit:

ESTIMATE OF LABOR AND MATERIAL FURNISHED TO TITUS COUNTY TEXAS, BY SMITH BROTHERS OF CROCKETT, TEXAS, UNDER THEIR CONTRACT WITH SAID COUNTY OF DATE. OCTOBER 10th. 1921.

Shouldering and cleaning ditches 2.9 Mi. @ \$492.40,	\$1,224.96
Earth Roadway Excavation @ 400. Cu Yds @ \$0.38	144.00
Scarifying 400 Stations @ \$6.00 per 100ft. Station,	2,400.00

It further appears to the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, that the foregoing estimate of the Engineer in the employ of Titus County, Texas is true and correct; that said labor and material shown by said estimate, which is the account of Smith Brothers for the same as provided by the said contract, has been furnished to Titus County Texas, and that said County now in fact has and is using and enjoying the same and

that said estimate is true and correct in each item thereof and the total thereof. The said labor and material has been furnished in strict compliance with the plans and specifications therefor and under the supervision of said Engineer.

It is, therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Commissioners Court of Titus, County, Texas, that the said estimate be and the same is now audited, allowed and ordered paid to the full amount thereof, the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars, according the terms of said contract between Titus County, Texas, and that the " Titus County, Texas, Road and Bridge Warrants, Series 1921" as described, and provided for in the said contract and the orders of this Court be now issued and delivered to Smith Brothers to evidence the debt of Titus, County, Texas, to them for said labor and material, as provided by said contract, which shall be executed and registered as the Law in such cases provides. There shall be credited however upon the first coupon of each warrants the amount of the interest accrued to this date so that the said warrants shall bear date only from this date.

It is further ordered that said contract and all orders approving the same heretofore made be now in all things ratified, approved, and confirmed."

The County Judge of Titus County, Texas, put the said motion for a vote of the members of the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" Whereupon County Commissioners, Edwards, Fleming, King voted "AYE" None voted "No" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

The foregoing minutes of the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas read and approved this the 21st day of October A.D. 1921
