When Commissioner Edwards, made a motion that the same be approved and seconded by Commissioner King, the County Judge put the motion before members of said Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" all of said Commissioners voted "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of of having prepared and published according to law a Supplement to the Delinquent Tax Records of Titus County Texas, on Motion by L.N.Old seconded by by W.M.Edwards, all present voting in favor of said motion, said motion declared carried,.

It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the Court that a supplement to the Delinquent Tax Record for Titus County, be prepared and published according to law, and that County Judge Dan M. Cook, secure the services of some competent person or persons as necessary to prepare said delinquent record as provided for by law.

In the matter of Transferring Funds. November, 14th, 1921.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of transferring Jury Funds to the Special Road Int. & Sinking Fund, and it appearing to the Commissioners Court, that the County Judge of this County, on the 4th day of October, 1921, transferred the sum of \$6000.00, from the Jury Fund to the Special Road

Int & Sinking Fund, and on the 24th day of October, the sum of \$1000.00, from said Jury Fund to the Special Road Inst. & Sinking Fund, to pay the interest on Road bonds then due; Commissioner King made a motion to approve the action of the County Judge in transferring of said funds, second by Commissioner Old, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" all of said members voted "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
