The County Judge put the motion before said members of said court with the request that those opposed vote no and those in favor of said motion to vote "I". Commissioners King, Flemings, Olds, Edwards all voted I the county Judge declared the Motion carried and ordered the clerk of Said court to draw warrants for same.
