Court open up by proclamation of Jno. J. Reeves, Sheriff, Titus County, Texas.

IN THE NATTER OF A DEMONSTRATION AGENT DURING THE YEAR 1922.

Notion by Commissioner Edwards and second by Commissioner King that last years contract with A.M.Sollege in connection with the farm demonstration agent be renewed. The County Judge put the motion before the members of said court with the request that as mang as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioners Fleming, King, Old and Edwards all voted "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of Transferring

Notion by Commissioner Edwards, and second by Commissioner Old to transfer all interest on daily balances at the Depository to the General County Fund, except that the interest on the Special Roads account shall be paid to the credit of that accounty The County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No", Commissioners Fleming, Old, King and Edwards, vote "Aye" the county Judge declared the motion earried and the order passed.

In the Natter of Dondenning Army Trucks.
