BE IT REMEMBERED That there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioner Court in and for Titus County, Texas, on the 10th day of April, 1922, with the following officers present to-wit; Hon Dan M. Cook, County Judge, Commissioners W.M.King, W.M.Edwards, W.A.Fleming, and L.H. Old, Clerk Ulman Brown. When the following proceedings were had to-wit;

Court opened by a proclamation of Sheriff John J. Reeves, Titus County, Texas.

In the Matter of allowing
Accounts?

On this day came on to be heard by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, accounts to be allowed when Commissioner King made a motion which was seconded by Commissioner Fleming that said accounts to be allowed as same are entered in Vol 2 Minutes of Accounts Allowed pages 119 to 121 inclusive /The County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Fleming, Old and Edwards all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the matter of approveing
Delinquent Tax Record.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court the matter of approveing the Delinquent Tax Record prepared by Tax Collector Herbert L. Smith, for the years of 1917 to 1920 inclusive, when Commissioner Edwards made a motion and seconded by Commissioner Fleming that the same be approved, The County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those appose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Fleming, Old and Edwards all voted "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed?

In the matter of Publishing
Delinquent Tax Record?

Motion by Commissioner Old and seconded by Commissioner King that the Delinquent Tax Record for the years 1917 to 1920 inclusive that the same be published as required by law, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioners King, Fleming, Old and Edwards all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the matter of approveing
County Official Monthly Expense Report?

Motion by Commissioner King and second by Commissioner Edwards that receipts be required of all officers for items entered on their monthly expense account; and all items for which no receipt is attached will be struck out of the officers report and disapproved. this order is effective as of January 1st. 1922. The County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Old, Edwards and Fleming all voted "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed?

In the matter of approving
Special County Auditor's Report.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of approving the report of Special County Auditor when Commissioner Edwards made a motion and second by Commissioner Fleming that said report be approved and same be published, that is, such parts of said report be published that will be of interest to the people of Titus County. The County Judge put the motion before the members of said court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Fleming, Old and Edwards all voted "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter approving
Tax Collector Herbert L. Smith Reports?

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, the January, February and March Reports of Tax Collector Herbert L. Smith. When Commissioner Old mad a motion that same be approved seconded by Commissioner King. The County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with request that as many as favored said motion vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Fleming, Old and Edwards all voted "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the matter of approving
Accounts.

Motion by Commissioner Edwards seconded by Commissioner Old that hereafter no accounts will be allowed by this court that are over 60 days old and order is made that the County Clerk shall have copy of this order published in a newspaper of this County. The County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court with a request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Fleming, Old and Edwards all "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
