Cook, County Judge, Commissioners W.M.King, W.M.Edwards, W.A.Edwards and L.H.Old, and Clerk Ulman Brown, when the following proceeding were had to-wit;

Court open by proclamation by John J.Reeves, Sheriff, Titus County, Texas.
In the Matter approving the
official Bond of Birt Binnion, Constable Pre No.6.

On this the 12th day of June, 1928, came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court, of Titus County, Texas, the official Bond of Birt Binnion, as Constable in and for Precinct No 6 Titus County, Texas, when Commissioner Old made a motion and seconded by Commissioner King that the same be approved, The County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioners King, Old, Edwards Fleming all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of approving Herbert L
Smith, Tax Collector, Annual Report.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of approving Herbert L. Smith, Tax Collector, Annual Report, and after examining same Commissioner Edwards made a motion and seconded by Commissioner Fleming that the same be approved, The County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "no" Commissioner King, Fleming, Edwards and Old all voted "Aye". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of Petition from
Common School Dist. No 15?

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court, a petition signed by A.T.Blalock and seven others of said District asking the court that Clabe Harris be appointed as Trustee in and for said District, Commissioner King made a motion that Clabe Harris be appointed as a Trustee for said District No 15 seconded

by Commissioner Old, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Old, Fleming, and Edwards all voted "Aye". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of approving
Tax Collectors' Reports

Motion by Commissioner Old and seconded by Commissioner King that the reports of Tax Collector Herbert L. Smith be approved, the county Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioners King, Old, Fleming and Edwards all voted "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of allowing Mrs. Hiram
Carpenter, funds

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court, of Titus County, Texas, the matter of allowing Mrs. Hiram Carpenter, funds, when Commissioner King made a motion and second by Commissioner Edwards that Mrs. Hiram Carpenter, be allowed the sum of \$10.00 per month out of Maintenance fund to paid monthly, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioners King, Edwards, Old and Fleming all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of Collecting
Delinquent Taxes.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court, of Titus County, Texas, the matter of collecting the Delinquent Taxes for said County, when Commissioner Edwards made a motion and second by Commissioner Fleming that the Tax Collector and County Attorney be ordered to proceed to collect the Delinquent Taxes at County's expenses the County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioners King, Fleming, Old and /Edwards all voted "Aye" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
