BE IT REMEMBERED That there was begun and holden a Special term of the Commissioners in and for Titus County, Texas, at the Court House in the City of Mount Pleasant, on this the 25th day of July, 1922, with the following officers present to-wit; Hon Dan M. Cook, County Judge, Commissioners W.A.Fleming, L.H.Old, W.M.King and W.M.Edwards, and Ulman Brown, Clerk, when the following proceeding were had to wit; Court open up by proclamation by the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas.

On this day came on to be considered by the Board of Equalization of Titus County, Texas, said Board being composed of W.M.King, W.M.Edwards, W.A. Fleming and L.H .Old, Commissioners of Titus County, Texas, the matter of rendition of property given in for taxes for the year of 1922, said Board being session four days and after examing all rendition of property in Titus County, Texas, found that some property should be raised, and ordered the clerk to notify those that should be raised to appear on Aug. 4th, 1922, and show cause, if any, why said property should not be raised, the County Judge put the motion Before the

members of said board for a vote with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" all vote "Aye", The County Judge declared motion carried and the order passed.
