Be it remembered that there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioner's Court in and for Titus County, Texas, at the Court House thereof on this 14th day of May, 1923, with the following officers present to wit; Hon Dan M. Cook, County Judge, Commissioners W.M. King, W.M. Edwards, W.A. Fleming and R.E. Hookeba, and Clerk, Ulman Brown, when the following proceeding were had to wit;

Court open up by proclamation by the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas.

In the Matter of Cancellation

Motion by King second by Fleming that certificate of cancellation issue to W.C. Hays on account Error in assessment also certificate cancellation to Geo Embers on 140 acres land abstract 614 H.P. In the Matter of Fed Calvert

as Maintainer Man, on Highways,

Motion by Commissioner King, second by Commissioner Edwards, to Fed Calvert Maintainer Man, to 30 cents per hour, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with request that as many as favor said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" all of said Commissioners voted "Aye" the county Judge declared the motion carried 235 and the order passed.
