

BE IT REMEMBERED, that a Special Term of Commissioners' Court in and for Titus County, Texas, was begun and holden on the 16th day of July A.D. 1923, with the following officers, present, to-wit: Dan M. Cook County Judge, W.M. King, W.M. Edwards, W.A. Fleming and R.E. Huokeba, Commissioners; Ulman Brown, County Clerk and W.L. Kelley Sheriff. Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF PERSONAL AND REAL PROPERTY  
RENDERED FOR TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1923.

On this day the 16th day of July A.D. 1923 the rendition sheets of the tax payers came on to be considered by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas,

The commissioners in and for Titus County, Texas, after taking the oath on the Equalization Board examined the rendition sheets of the Tax-Assessor, showing the rendition of Real and Personal property belonging to the tax-payers of Titus County, Texas and made an order that the Clerk of said court notify those showing insufficient rendition, to be and appear before this Board of Equalization on the 30th and 31st days of July A.D. 1923, and show cause why the said property <sup>should not ..show</sup> ... <sup>higher valuation and the</sup> Board being in session three days, adjourned.
