

BE IT REMEMBERED, that a Special Term of the Commissioners' Court in and for Titus County, Texas, was begun and holden on the 30th and 31st days of July A.D. 1923, with the following officers present, to-wit: Dan M. Cook, County Judge; W.M. King, W.M. Edwards, W.A. Fleming and R.E. Huckeba, Commissioners; Ulman Brown County Clerk and W.L. Kelley, Sheriff. Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff and the following proceedings were had to-wit:

On this the 30th day of July A.D. 1923, came on to be considered by the Board of Equalization of Titus County, Texas, composed of Commissioners W.M. King, W.M. Edwards, W.A. Fleming and R.E. Huckeba, the matter of raising the valuation of the property belonging to the various tax-payers, who had been heretofore notified to appear and answer herein, and after being in session two days said court adjourned.
