Cook County Judge; W.M. King, W.M. Edwards, W.A. Fleming and R.E. Ruckeba, Commissioners, Ulman Brown County Clerk and W.L. Kelley Sheriff. Court was opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff and the following proceedings were had to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE REPORT OF
HERBERT L. SMITH, Tax Collector.

Motion by Commissioner Edwards and Second by Commissioner King that the report of Herbert L. Smith, Tax Collector be approved. The County Judge put the motion before the members of the Commissioners' Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "no". All voted "AYE" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING
OFFICERS' QUARTERLY REPORTS.

On this day came on for approval the following Officers' Quarterly Reports, to-wit: J.A. Lee, Justice of the Peace, Pre #6; H.B. Green, J.P. Pre. #8; R.S. Owens J.P. Pre. #4; W.M. King, J.P. Pre. #3; E.A. Tigert, J.P. Pre #7; R.A. Lawler, J.P. Pre. #5; Sam Porter, J.P. Pre. #1; Sam Williams, County Attorney; W.E. McClintock, District Clerk; Ulman Brown County Clerk; W.L. Kelley, Sheriff and J.S. Horn, Constable Pre. # 7, and after examining said reports, Commissioner Fleming made a motion to approve said reports, seconded by Commissioner King. The County Judge put the motion before the Commissioners' Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "No". All voted "AYE". The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING OFFICIAL BONDS OF
W.L. KELLEY, SHERIFF, and R.S. Owens, Public Weigher
for Pre. No. 4.

The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
