THE STATE OF TEXAS  
COUNTY OF TITUS

On this the 8th day of October 1922, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, was convened in regular session, with the County Judge and all of the County Commissioners and the County Clerk being present, when there came before said Court the matter of correcting errors appearing in an order of said Court passed on the 14th day of May, 1922, authorizing the issuance of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) of Titus County Funding Warrants, and after due consideration and upon motion of Commissioner Edwards, seconded by Commissioner Link, the following order was passed by vote of 4 votes for its passage to 0 votes against its passage, to-wit:

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of May, 1922, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County adopted an order providing for the issuance of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) of Titus County Funding Warrants for the purpose of refunding and postponing the payment thereof, and wherein said order recited in the two paragraphs last appearing on the second page of said order that the scrip therein listed aggregated Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) and that claims to the extent of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.) additional for which scrip would be issued and refunded, which recitations were in error there being on said date in fact only approximately Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) of warrants outstanding against the General Fund of said County; and

WHEREAS it was the purpose of said Court to refund the then outstanding warrants against the General Fund of said County, aggregating Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), and to refund additional warrants to be issued against said General Fund in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5000.00), making an aggregate total of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) of funding warrants to be issued; and

Whereas, said order of date May 14th, in the first paragraph thereof following the warrant form and coupon form, directing the delivery to the security Trust Company of warrants numbers one (1) to twelve (12), in lieu of the outstanding warrants against said General Fund, and the last paragraph of said order preceding the signing of the minutes by the County Judge and County Commissioners, authorized the County Judge to deliver to the Security Trust Company warrants numbers one (1) to twelve (12) inclusive, whereas it should have directed the delivery to the security Trust Company of warrants numbers one (1) to ten (10) inclusive, aggregating Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), and it is the purpose of this court to amend said paragraphs of said order so as to conform to the facts herein set out.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, that said order of the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, passed on the 14th day of May, 1922, be amended so that the two paragraphs last appearing on page two of said order shall be amended and as amended shall read as follows:

"That scrip herein listed, aggregating the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) dollars be and the same is hereby in all things validated and held and declared to be valid, subsisting, binding and unextinguished obligations against the General Fund of Titus County, and the acts of the County officers in issuance of said scrip are hereby in all things ratified and confirmed.

"That claims to the extent of Five thousand (\$5000.00) dollars, duly approved for and on account of current expenses of Titus County and claims lawfully incurred against and payable out of the General Fund of said County, shall be evidenced by the issuance of County scrip against the General Fund of said County."

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the paragraph immediately following the warrant form and coupon form, as said out in said order of date .....

May 14, 1923, be amended, and that said paragraph, as so amended, shall be and read as follows:

"BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that warrants numbers one (1) to ten (10) inclusive, herein authorized, be executed and delivered to said Security Trust Company, Austin, Texas, the owner and holder of the original warrants herein listed, aggregating ten thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars, upon surrender and cancellation of said original warrants."

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the last paragraph of said order of date May 14, 1923, be amended, and that said paragraph, as so amended, shall be and read as follows:

"IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Dan M. Cook, County Judge of Titus County, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to take and have charge of said Funding Warrants, and he shall have authority to deliver said warrants numbers 1 to 10 inclusive, aggregating ten thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars, to the Security Trust Company when the original warrants herein listed have been surrendered to him and cancelled; and shall deliver the remainder of said Funding Warrants, in installments, under further orders of this Court"
