

JANUARY term Commissioner Court

January 14th, 1924.

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT there was begun and holden a Regular Term of the Commissioners Court in and for Titus County, Texas, at the Court House thereof on this the 14th day of January 1924, with the following officers present to wit; Hon Dan M. Cook, County Judge Commissioners present W.M.King, W.M.Edwards, R.E.Huckeba and W.A.Flemings, Ulman Brown Clerk when the following proceeding were had to wit;

Court open by proclamation by the Sheriff of Titus County, Texas.

In the Matter of Allowing Accounts.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of allowing accounts, and after examing same Commissioner King made a Motion to allow said accounts as the same is entered in Vol 3 Minutes of Accounts Allowed second by Commissioner Edwards, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with request that as many as favor said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" all of said Commissioners voting "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of approving

Estimates No 1, Roads A1. and No 35.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, the matter of approving Estimates No 1, for Road A1 and No 35, for A1 \$6776.91 and No 35, \$4062.33, when Commissioner Edwards made a motion to allow said Estimates and deduct the amount heretofore paid on Estimates, and allow Engineer account for the the sum \$491.00, less \$100 heretofore paid, second by Commissioner King the County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with the request that as many as favor said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" all of said Commissioners voting "Aye" the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of Allowing

Paupers

On this day came on to be considered the matter of allowing paupers funds when Commissioner Edwards made a motion to allow Alex Justice the sum of \$7.50 per month, and Ed Walker the sum of \$5.00 per month, to be paid the 15th of each month out of Maintenance Fund, until further order of this court, second by Commissioner Fleming, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with the request that as many as favor said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" All of said Commissioners voting "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of Deficiency as an officer,
of Mrs Tom Price and I.H.Hammonds.

On this day motion made by Commissioner Fleming that the County Attorney to notify boundman of Mrs. Tom Price and I.H.Hammonds to pay claim of County, otherwise to enter suit not later then February 1st, 1924, to collect said claims, second by Commissioner Edwards, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favor said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" all of said Commissioners voting "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of the Court House Square.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of the Court House Square, when Commissioner Edwards made a motion and second by Commissioner Hookeba that Commissioner Court turn over to the City Council the Court House Square, said land to be turned over being all the Square surrounding the Court House reaching from the concrete wall around the Court House to the street on all four sides, but all rights and privileges in and to the four walks ten feet wide to the four entrances of the Court House, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with request that as many as favor said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioners Edwards, Fleming and Hookeba voting "Aye" Commissioner King voting "No" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
