On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of allowing accounts, and after examing same Commissioner King made a Motion to allow said accounts as the same is entered in Vol 5 Minutes of accounts allowed second by Commissioner Edwards, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said Court for a vote with request that as many as favor said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" all of said Commissioners voting "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
