July Regular Term, July 14th, 1924.

Be it remembered that there was begun and helden a regular term of the Commissioners Court in and for Titus County, at the Court House thereof, on this the 14th, 1924, with the following officers present to wit; Hen Dan M. Cook, County Judge, Commissioners, W.A.Fleming, R.E.Huckeba, W.M.King and W.M.Edwards, Clerk, Ulman Brown Clerk of said Court.

Court open up by proclamation of the Sheriff.

In the Matter of allowing accounts.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus the matter of allowing accounts, and after examining same Commissioner Fleming made a motion and second by Commissioner King that same be allowed and ordered paid, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favor said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No" Commissioner King, Fleming, Huckeba and Edwards all voted "Aye" the County Judge declared motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of allowing
Paupers funds.

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, the matter allowing the following persons maintenance Marshall Jones from \$5.00 to \$7.50, Heward Wade from \$10.00 to \$7.50, Mandy Pebl from \$10.00 to \$7.50, Jehn Smith \$10.00, Claminta Castile the sum of \$7.50, the said sums to be paid the 10th of each month until further order of this court Commissioner Edwards made the motion and second by Commissioner Fleming, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favor said motion to vote "Aye" and those oppose to vote "No", Commissioner King, Fleming, Huckeba and Edwards all vote "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

In the Matter of the County Buying
Tractor for Roads

On this day came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court the matter of the County buying a Tractor for the Roads building, when Commissioner Edwards made a motion and second by Commissioner King that the County Judge be authorized to offer for bids for the sale of a Tractor for said County and purchase under the best bid to said County, the County Judge put the motion before the members of said court for a vote with the request that as many as favor said motion to vote "Aye" and those opposed to vote "No", Commissioner King, Fleming, Edwards and Huckeba all voted "Aye" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
