

## July Special Term Commissioners Court,

July 21st, 1924.

Be it remembered, that a Special Term of Commissioners Court in and for Titus County, Texas, was begun and holden on the 21st day of July, A.D. 1924, with following officers, present, to-wit; Dan M. Cook, County Judge, W.M. King, W.M. Edwards, W.A. Fleming and H.E. Hookeba, Commissioners; Ulman Brown, Clerk, and W.L. Kelley Sheriff, Court opened by a proclamation of the Sheriff, when the following proceedings were had to-wit;

In the Matter of Personal and Real Property  
Rendered for Taxes for the Year 1924.

On this day the 21st day of July 1924, the rendition sheets of the tax payers came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas. The Commissioners in and for Titus County, Texas, after taking the oath on the Equalisation Board examined the rendition sheets of the Tax-Assessor, showing the rendition of real and personal property belonging to the tax-payers of Titus County, Texas and made an order that the Clerk of said Court notify those showing insufficient rendition, to be and appear before this Court of equalisation on the 4th day of Aug. 1924 and show cause why the said property should not show higher valuation and the board being in session two days adjourned.
