BE IT REMEMBERED that there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioner's court in and for Titus County Texas on Nov 10th AD 1924 with the following members present to-wit Dan M. Cook County Judge W.M. King W.M. Edwards W.A. Fleming Commissioners Ulman Brown County Clerk W.L. Kelley Sheriff by his deputy Elmer Cato when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

County Judge Dan M. Cook, being absent, Commissioner Edwards acted as presiding Judge of said Court, When the following proceedings were had to wit

IN THE MATTER CATTLE DIPPING TITUS COUNTY TEXAS.:

On this day come on to heard by the Commissioner's Court of Titus County Texas, the matter of Tick Modification, in and for Titus County Texas. ; and after discussing same Commissioner King made a motion Second by Commissioner Fleming, to allow R.H. Clayton, as Superintendent, of Cattle dipping all South of White Oak Creek, a salary of \$75.00 per month, to begin Nov 15th 1924, and allowed Fred Fishback, as Superintendent, of Cattle dipping known as Between the Creeks of said County, that is between, White Oak and Sulphur Creeks, and for his service, a salary of \$50.00 per month, beginning, on said Nov 15th 1924, and both employe, to be paid out of the General County Fund on the 15th of Each Month, the presiding Judge, put the motion before the members of the said Court, with the request that as many favored said motion to vote Aye, and those opposed, No. Commissioner King, Fleming and Hookeba, all voted Aye, the presiding judge declared the motion carried, and the order passed,

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING HOWARD WADE (COL)
Funds out of the Maintenance, .

Motion by King, Second by Fleming, to allow Howard Wade, \$10.00 per month hereafter instead of \$7.50 as it has been heretofore out of the Maintenance, fund warrant to be issued the 15th of Each Month, the Presiding Judge Edwards put the motion before the court, with a request that all favor said motion to vote AYE and all opposed to vote NO. King, Fleming and Hookeba, all vote AYE the Presiding Judge declared said motion passed and order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF FARM HOME EXTENSION WORK
AND COUNTY AGRICULTURAL AGENT.

On this day come on to be considered by the Commissioner's Court of Titus County Texas, in retaining the work of Farm Home extension work and County Agricultural Agent, and after considering same, Commissioner Hookeba made a motion second by Commissioner King, that the work of the Farm Home extension work and County Agricultural No

Agent, be retained for another year, and for the service for each work the County agrees, to pay out of the General County fund, \$1000.00 Dollars, per year for each work, and to be paid monthly the Presiding Judge, Edwards, put the motion before the body, for a vote with the request that all favored said matter to vote AYE and all that opposed said matter to vote No. King Fleming and Huexeba Vote AYE the presiding Judge Edwards declared said motion passed and order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF RESIGNATION OF CONSTABLE
J.S.HORN OF PREC NO 7, Titus County Texas.

Motion by Huexeba Second by King, that the Resignation of J.S.Horn as constable of Prec No 7 of Titus County Texas be excepted, the presiding Judge Edwards put the motion before the court for a vote, All favored said motion to vote AYE and all opposed said motion to vote No. King, Fleming and Huexeba All voted Aye the presiding Judge declared said motion passed and order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF ACCOUNT OF CHAS ROBINSON

Motion by King, Second by Huexeba that claim of \$42.36 Monthly allowance for disability from accident on R.S. work sixty per cent 60% of said amount was allowed being \$25.40 and no further allowance would be allowed the said Robinson, the Presiding Judge Edwards put the motion before the court for a vote All favored said motion to Vote AYE, and all opposed said motion to vote No, King Fleming and Huexeba All voted Aye the presiding Judge declared said motion passed and order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING ACCOUNTS;

Motion by King, Second by Huexeba, that the accounts be approved as listed in Minutes of Accounts allowed, in Vol 3 pages minutes of said Commissioner's court, the ~~Presiding~~ the Presiding Judge Edwards put the motion before the court with the request that as many favored the motion to Vote Aye and all opposed to Vote No. Commissioners, King, Fleming and Huexeba All voted "AYE" None voted "NO" the Presiding Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF CANVASING THE GENERAL ELECTIONS RETURNS

On this day came on to be considered, canvassing and declaring the General Election, held on the 4th day of Nov A.D. 1924, Commissioner King, made a motion Second by Commissioner Huexeba, to declare the results of said Election of each ^{Candidate} ~~prec~~ as same as entered, in Vol One ~~744~~ Records of Elections returns, pages, 85-90 inclusive, and for manager of each prec. not including Prec. No. One, shall be paid, \$4.00 per day, and for each Clerk of each prec, including Managers of Prec No One, shall be paid \$2.00 out of the General County Fund, The Presiding Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many favored said motion to vote "AYE and All opposed to Vote "NO". Commissioners King Fleming and Huexeba all voted "AYE" None voted "NO" the Presiding Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
