

*Order to have*

ORDER OF STOCK ELECTION

On this the 17th day of February 1925, came on to be considered by the County Judge of Titus County Texas the petition of D.C. Oliver and nineteen others freeholders of the hereinafter subdivision of Titus County Texas; the said signers being resident freeholders in said subdivision and qualified voters under the constitution and laws of the State of Texas for an order of election in the limits and confines of said subdivision for the purpose of enabling the freeholders therein to determine whether or not hogs, sheep goats jacks and jennette shall be permitted to run at large therein said subdivision being described by metes and bounds as follows BEGINNING at a point on Sulphur Creek the NE corner of the F.E. Greer survey Thence South with EB line of F.E. Greer survey to North S line of Jno Prather Sur Thence S with EB line of Jon R. Porter sur Thence S with EB line of Somier Booths Sur to the NE line of M.E.P R RY Sur Thence E to the NE corner of M.E.P and RY Sur; Thence South with EB line of M.E.P and RY Sur Thence South with EB line of Chas V. White Sur Thence S with EB line of T.W. Morris Sur to the NE line of B.B. and C. RY Sur to the NE corner of same Thence S with EB line of B.B. B. and Co RY Sur to White Oak Creek Being the Maple Springs Corner School District

And it appearing to the undersigned Judge of such court that such petition was on the 9th day of February 1925 heard and granted by the Commissioner's Court of Titus County Texas and ordered that such election be held on the 28th day of March 1925 and that the Judge of said County issue and order therefor and cause public notice to be given as required by law.

Now therefore by virtue of the authority vested in me under such order and the law I, E.L. Myers County Judge of Titus County Texas do hereby order that on the 28th day of March 1925 at Wilkinson School house in said subdivision in Titus County Texas an election shall be held for the purpose of enabling the freeholders of such subdivision to determine whether or not hogs, sheep, goats jacks, and Jennetts shall be permitted to run at large within the confines and limits of said subdivision in Titus County Texas that the poles shall be opened for such election at the said Wilkinson school house at 8 o'clock AM and close at 7 o'clock P.M. on the hereinbefore designated.

D.C. Oliver and A.V. Flannagin are appointed as managers of said election and election managers being free holders and resident qualified voters of said subdivision they shall appoint their own Clerks they deem necessary to the proper conduct of said election No person shall vote at such election unless he is a free holder and also a qualified under the constitution and laws of the State of Texas all votes of such election shall be by ballot the voters desiring to prevent the animals designated herein from running at large shall place upon their ballot the words: "FOR THE STOCK LAW" and those favoring the allowing such animals to run at large "AGAINST THE STOCK LAW"

On or before the 10th day after such election the persons holding such election shall make due returns of all the votes cast for and against said proposition to the County Judge of said County who will tabulate and count said returns and ascertain and proclaim the result of said election in the manner prescribed by law.

Public notice of this order shall be given at least 30 days before the date of such election by publication thereof in some newspaper published in said county.
