IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING DEPOSITORY BOND

On this the 27th day of February 1925 came on to be considered by the commissioner's court it being a special session duly called by the County Judge the matter of approving the bond of the First National Bank of Mt. Pleasant, as depository for county and school funds, The bond for the County funds being for the sum of \$142,440.00 with O.W.Candle, J.H.Smith H.A.Smith H.F.Moore, and J.R.Hart sureties and the bond for the School funds for the amount of \$90,000.00 with the same sureties .

On Motion by Luna second by Cameron to approve said bonds the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
