

SPECIAL MARCH TERM A.D 1925

Be it remembered that on this the 2nd day of March AD 1925, there was begun and holden a Special Session of the Commissioner's Court of Titus County Texas with the following officers present to-wit E.L. Myers Judge Commissioners King Luna C. Cameron and Lindsay all present and W.R. McClintock Clerk of Court with the following proceedings were had, to-wit.

IN THE MATTER OF MAKING FINAL SETTLEMENT WITH H.S WILDER AND OTHER SPECIAL ROAD ACCOUNTS

On this the 2nd day of March, Commissioner C. Cameron made a motion seconded by Luna to allow accounts as listed in Minutes of accounts allowed in Vol # 3 Page. of special Session, March Term. The County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that all favored said motion to vote "AYE" all opposed to vote "NO" Commissioners Luna Lindsay C. Cameron and King all voted AYE" The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF TRANSFERRING FUNDS.

On this 2nd day of March 1925, the same being a called session of the Commissioner's Court the same having been called by the County Judge same on so be considered the matter of transferring funds Commissioner C. Cameron made a motion to transfer \$1000.00 from the Court and House and Jail fund to the Treasurer's fund. The County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those who opposed to vote "NO" C. Cameron Lindsay Luna and King voted in the affirmative there being no dissenting vote the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

The above and foregoing minutes read and approved in open court this the 2nd day of March AD 1925.
