IN THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS
COUNTY, TEXAS. APRIL TERM A D 1925.

On this the 13th, day of April, 1925, E.L. Myers, County Judge, C F Lindsay, W.M. King, Alfred Luna, and W.T. Cameron, commissioners being present, came on to be heard the petition of O M Fuquay setting forth the facts that the East 1/2 of Lot No. 7 in Block 9 of the original town of Winfield, Texas, as shown by plat and plan of said addition, of record in Vol. 14 page 344, Deed Records of Titus Co., Texas, was rendered and paid upon the tax collectors rolls, for the years 1918, 1919, 1920, 1921, as the East one half of Block No. 9 and that for the years 1923 and 1924 said property was rendered and paid upon the tax rolls as one lot, That the West one half of 7 in Block 9 of the aforesaid addition was rendered and paid upon the tax rolls for the years 1920, 1921, 1922, 1923 and 1924, under the erroneous assessment of lots 4 and 5 in Block 13 of said addition, said property now belonging to the said O M Fuquay and wife, Josie C. Fuquay said O.M. Fuquay, praying the Court that in view of fact that said taxes having been paid; upon said property, that the Tax. Collector of Titus County, Texas, be authorized and directed to sign a tax certificate showing that said taxes have been paid, upon said property, and that an order be passed, which shall be spread upon the minutes of this Court,

And the Court after hearing the proff as to the above matter, a motion was made by Alfred Luna and seconded by J T Camerson that said petition be in all things granted, and said motion was pat before the Court by the County Judge, and J.T. Cameron and Alfred Luna and W M King and C.P. Lindsay voted yes, and the County Judge declared said motion carried,

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordered, directed adjudged and decreed that the Tax Collector of Titus County, Texas is directed, authorized and empowered to sign a tax certificate showing said taxes as above set forth in the aforesaid part of this instrument paid; and the Clerk of this Court is directed that this order be spread upon the minutes of this Court, and it is ordered.

IN THE MATTER OF RETURNS OF COUNTY TRUSTEE ELECTION.

On this the 15th day of April the commissioner court of Titus County Tex as opened and examined the returns for the election of County School Trustees held on the 4th day of April 1925, the same being the first Saturday in said month and after examining said returns it appears to the court that Clay Russell received 251 votes for County School Trustee at large and T.G. Temple received 175 votes, for County School Trustee at large B.C. Branch received 77 votes for County School Trustee from Commissioners' precinct No One Fred Traylor received 42, votes for County School Trustee for Commissioners' precinct No 2, That Alex Gingle received 9 votes for County School Trustee for Commissioners' precinct No 3 and W.E. Wilson received 39 votes for County School Trustee for Commissioners' Precinct No 3 It is therefore ordered that the county clerk issue a commission to Clay Russell as County School Trustee at large a commission to B.C. Branch for County School Trustee for Commissioner's precinct No One and a commission to W.E. Wilson for County School Trustee for Commissioner's precinct No 3.

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING FUNDS TO PAUPERS

On this day came on to be considered by the commissioner's court the matter of allowing Mrs Bailey \$15.00 per month instead of \$10.00 per month as heretofore been granted Commissioner Lindsay made a motion that Mrs Bailey be allowed \$15.00 per month instead of Ten and that Morrison hereafter be allowed \$10.00 per month instead of \$15.00 as heretofore granted Seconded by Commissioner, Cameron The County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" All voted "AYE" and the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 16th day of April same on to be considered ,the matter of allowing accounts
Commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner King to allow accounts as
listed in Minutes of accounts allowed in Vol 43 page _____. The county Judge put the
motion before the court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote "AY"
and all opposed to vote "NO" all commissioners Voted Yes the County Judge declared the
Motion carried and the order passed.
