On this the 11th day of May Came on to be considered the matter of allowing accounts Commissioner Luna Made a Motion seconded by Commissioner King to allow all accounts as listed in the Minutes of accounts allowed in Vol 5 pages. the County Judge put the Motion before the court with the request that as Many as favored said Motion to vote AYE all opposed to vote "NO" All voted Aye the County Judge declared the Motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF HIRING I. N. WILLIAMS SPECIAL ATTY TO COLLECT DELINQUENT TAXES.

May 11th 1925 The following offer was made by I. N. Williams Attorney and accepted King Luna Cameron and Lindsey voting AYE, I. N. Williams, Attorney to handle the collection of all delinquent taxes due Titus County at this time to ascertain and collect taxes due the Titus not rendered or overlooked on the rolls to look after all tax suits; to have surveyed where necessary to ascertain chain titles when necessary to bring suits and do such other and further acts as may be necessary to the collection of all taxes due Titus County; said Williams to use his judgment in all these things and any expenses incurred as to surveys or titles sheets to be at his own expense and for such services Titus County is to pay him 10% gross of all taxes collected for and due to the County and this contract of employment to run and be in full force for two years from date hereof but the said Williams is to proceed with the collections as soon as possible and prosecute same with reasonable dispatch.

Commissioner Cameron made a motion to except said offer and commissioner Luna seconded said motion and the county Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as Many as favored said motion to vote "AYE" those opposed to vote No. All voted Aye the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
