

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the 10th day of August there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioner's court in and for Titus County TEXA with the following officers present to-wit:

E.L. Myers Judge W.M. King, A.J. Lana, J.T. Cameron and C.P. Lindsay Commissioners and W.B. McClintock Clerk of Court when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF REDUCING ALLOWANCE TO MRS LENA BAILEY

On this date, Aug 10th 1925, came on to be considered the matter of reducing the allowance of Mrs Lena Biley pauper and after discussing the matter on motion by Lana second by Cameron to reduce said allowance from \$15.00 to \$10.00 the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all members of the court voted AYE and No "NO" the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF A LOWING RACHEL TABB COLORED FUNDS.

On this the 10th day of Augu AD 1925, came on to be considered by the Commissioner's Court the matter of allowing Rachel TABB colored the amount of \$5.00 a month as pauper on motion by Lindsay seconded by Lana the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all members of the court voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTERS OF DISTRIBUTING THE TAX LEVY For 1925

On this the 10th day of August 1925 came on to be considered by the Commissioner's Court the matter of distributing the tax levy and after discussing the matter Commissioner Cameron made a motion second by Commissioner Lana that there be placed in the General County interest and sinking fund the amount of Fifteen (15) cents on the One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars valuation of taxable property in Titus County, TEXAS and the remaining Ten Cents of the Twenty- Five Cents of the constitutional limit for General County purposes be placed in the General County Fund., that 7-1/2 cents of the constitutional limit for road and bridge purposes be placed in the Road and Bridge interest and sinking fund, and the remaining 7-1/2 cents be placed in the road and bridge fund, and that all other funds remain the same as passed by the Court in its regular February meeting. the County Judge put the motion before the body with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to Vote "NO" all members voted in the affirmative and the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed/.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING LUTHER TAYLOR'S REPORT

On this the 10th day of August AD1925 Commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lana to approve Tax Collector's report for the Month of July AD 1925. The County Judge put the motion before the members of the court with the request that as many favored said motion to Vote Aye and those opposed to Vote NO. all members voted Aye , the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING ACCOUNTS

On this the 10th day of August AD 1925, Commissioner King Made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lgna to approve all account as listed in mimtee of account allowed in Vol 5 pages ____ The County Judge put the Motion before the members of the Court with the request that as many favored said motion to vote "AYE" all opposed to Vote "NO" all members voted AYE the County Judge Declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF ESTABLISHING TWO NEW VOTING BOXES.

On this the 10th day of August AD 1925, Commissioner Lindsay made a motion Seconded by Commissioner Cameron to establish two new Voting Boxes in the City of Mt.Pleasant, Titus County TEXAS as here to fore there has been only two Nos 1 and 8 these two voting boxes shall be numbered 13 and 14, n the four shall be numbered 1, 8 , 13, and 14, and shall be divided into precincts and sections as follows, Voting Box No. 1 shall begin at the E.E .Corner of the Lazarus and Williams Store a Two story brick building, and runs South along the Pittsburg Road, on the West side of said Road to the Precinct line, and then beginning at the Jefferson Hotel and along the Mt.Pleasant and Winfield Road, to the Precinct Line all in this section will vote in Voting Box No. One, John Hargrove is appointed Election Manager, of this said Box,

No 8 shall be as follows, Shall be gin at the First National Bank of Mt.Pleasant TEXAS thence North along the Main St and the Mt.Pleasant and Talco Road to the Voting Precinct Line, and then Begin at the First National Bank of Mt.Pleasant TEXAS running East along St. between said Bank and the Lilienstern Bros Dry Good Store along said St, continuing a long the road known as the Geo L Keith Road, all in this section between the two roads shall be in Voting Box No 8 , and shall vote in said Box, Forst Stephenson is election Manager,

VOTING BOX, No. 13. Shall be as follows Shall begin at Pat Temples Garage, where the Mt.Pleasant and Winfield Road, intersects the Square then West along said road to the Voting Precinct Line, then begins at Swint's Bros Drug Co On North along the Main St .continuing a long the Mt.Pleasant and Talco Road, to the Voting Precinct Line All in between these two roads and Streets shall be in voting Box No 13 and shall vote in said Box, Jas G. McClintock is appointed election Manager,

Voting Box No 14, Shall be as follows, Shall begin at the Lilienstern Bros Dry Good Store, along the St. between said store and the First National Bank a long said et . and road known as the Geo L Keith road, along said road to the Voting Precinct Line, then begins at the Jefferson Filing Station now owned by Lilienstern and Branch, along the Pittsburg and Mt.Pleasant road South to the voting Precinct Line, all in between these two roads shall be in voting Box No 14 and shall vote in said box, ~~Manager~~ W.M. Henderson is appointed election Manager,

The County Judge put the Motion before the Members of said court with the request that all favored said motion to vote Aye and all opposed to vote No. all members voted "AYE" the County Judge declared said motion carried and the order passed.

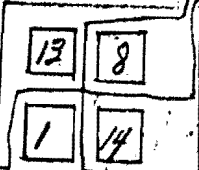

That we, Ford Motor Co. by W.A. Ford sole and exclusive owner as principal and A.B. Gilpin and Sam Coffey; as sureties are held and firmly bound unto the Commissioners, Court of Titus County, Texas, in the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, for the payment of which we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators successors and assigns, jointly and severly by these presents:

And conditioned of the above obligation issued that whereas, the above bounden Ford Motor Company was on the 10th, day of August, 1925, duly appointed by the Commissioner's Court of said County official representative of said County for a County Test station for the testing of headlights on motor vehicles and motorcycles under and by virtue of the provisions of an act passed by the 39th, Legislature of the State of Texas, the said act being House Bill No. 23 passed at the regular session of said legislature and approved by the Governor February 27th, 1925.

THE STATE OF TEXAS
COUNTY OF TITUS....

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, Whereas, the St. Louis Southwestern, Railway Company, of Texas, did, on the 10 day of Aug. AD 1925. file its application and petition with the Commissioner's Court of Titus County, Texas, applying for the right, privilege and easement to lay, construct, maintain and operate a single line track over and across the public road or highway, Near Winfield, Titus County, Texas, and said track is desired to serve the premises and lignite mine of J F O'Neill the exact location and place of crossing said public Highway and Road being as follows;

A Spur track to turn out of the main track of the St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company of Texas, at Valuation Chaining Station 359 plus 41.7 Mile Post C-486.41, with a Number 10 turnout on a 6 degree and 5 minute curve to the left, extending in a Westerly and Southerly direction, at 77.6 feet compounding to a 9 degree curve and continuing to point of tangent at Station 19 plus 58.4 Thence on tangent crossing the center of State Highway Number One at Station 12 plus 61 and continuing on tangent to and at Station 18 plus 00."

And, Whereas, said application came to be heard on the 10th, day of Aug. AD 1925, and same was duly considered by said Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, at a session thereof, and it was the opinion of the Court that said application should be granted.

Thereupon, Commissioner Cameron offered the following Resolution;

Resolved that Titus County Grant the St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company of Texas, an easement and the right and privilege to construct, operate and maintain a single line Track on over and across the public highway to serve the premises and lignite mine of J F O'Neill, near Winfield, Titus County, Texas, and that the County Judge be and he is hereby empowered and directed to execute, and deliver the necessary instruments, in writing to the St. Louis Southwestern, Railway Company of Texas, granting it the said easement and that this Resolution and Instrument be placed of record on Minutes of said Court;

In obedience to said Resolution and action of the Commissioners, Court of Titus County and acting by and Through E L Myers, its duly elected County Judge Titus County, hereby grants the St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company of Texas, an easement on and over the public highway at and near Winfield, Texas, the particular location being described hereinabove, and the right, franchise and privilege is also granted said St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company of Texas, to lay, construct, maintain, and operate a single line track over and across said public highway above described, said easement being granted to the St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company of Texas, for so long as it may use and operate said track and when the same shall be abandoned for more than a period of five, Years, the same shall revert to Titus County and the St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company of Texas, shall be required to take up its rails and restore said highway.
