

BE IT REMEMBERED that on this the Second Monday, in September AD 1925 same being 14th day of September AD 1925 there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioner's court of Titus County TEXAS, with the following officers present to-wit E.L. Myers Judge J.T. Cameron C.P. Lindsey, W.M. King and A.J. Luna Commissioner's and W.S. McClintock Exofficio Clerk of Court when the following proceedings were had to-wit

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING ACCOUNTS,

On this the 14th day of Sept AD 1925 Commissioner Luna Made a motion second by commissioner King to allow all accounts as listed in minutes of accounts allowed in Vol 3 page _____ the county Judge put the motion before the body with the request that as many favored said motion to vote AYE all opposed to Vote NO. All voted AYE, the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF BUILDING BRIDGE:

On this the 14th, day of Sept. 1925. came on to be considered by the Commissioner's Court of Titus County, at its regular Sept. meeting, the matter of cooperating with Camp County in building a County line bridge across Cypress Creek at the Beason Crossing on said Creek, After considering the matter Commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by Commissioner Cameron that Titus County pay one hundred (\$100.00) dollars, on the construction of said Bridge, the County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote Aye; and Those opposed to vote, NO. all members, voted in the affirmative and the County Judge, declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING FUNDS:

On this the 14th, day of September, 1925, came on to be considered by the Commissioners, Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of paying Dr. Beck of Winfield, Texas, for his services in attending Harmon Cox; a pauper during the last illness of said Cox; it appearing to the court that Dr. Beck had made 35 or forty trips to see said pauper and had been to considerable, expenses in doing so Commissioner Cameron made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Luna, to pay Dr. Beck out of the paupers fund the sum of \$50.00 to cover the value of the medicines, given to said pauper, and his expense in going to the said paupers home. The County Judge, put the motion before the body with the request that as many as favored the motion to AYE and those opposed to vote no all members, voted in the affirmative, the County Judge declared, the motion carried and the order passed.

IN MATTER OF LOWERING TAX OF CHAS, CARR:

On this the 14th, day of Sept. came on to be considered by the Commissioner's Court of Titus County Texas, the matter of lowering, the rendition on Charley Carr's land in 1924. near Talco, Texas, and after considering the matter and finding that the said Carr had 650 acres of land near Talco which had been rendered by the Tax assessor at \$20.00 per acre, and that all other land around and adjoining, said Carr's land was valued at 10.00 an acre and less, Commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner, Lindsey, that said assessment belowered to the amount of \$10.00 an acre and that the collector said taxes at the rate of \$10.00 an acre in said, of \$20100 the County Judge,
