W.L.Myers Judge and presiding thereof, Commissioners Cameron, Luns, King and Lindsey all present and W.E.McClintock Clerk, when the followins proceedings were had to-wit

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING . W.T.MONROE AND CO

On this the 24th day of October AD1925 at its special October Meeting came on to be considered by the Commissioners court of Titus County, TEXAS, the matter of paying W.T.Monroe and Company for repair work on the County Jail. AFTER visiting the Jail and inspecting the work and finding it satisfactorily done commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by commissioner Lindsey that the account be paid. The amount of which beins \$889.85 The County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" Those opposed to vote "N O" all members voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING J.S.REDFEARIN,

On this the 24th day of October 1925 came on to be considered by the commissioners court the matter of paying J.S.Redfearin for a chain to be used and being used in the road and bridge work of Titu County, Commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by commissioner CAMERON that Redfearin be paid \$2.00 out of the road and bridge fund for said chain. The COUNTY JUDGE put the motion before the body with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE " those opposed to vote "NO" all members voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING OFFICIAL BOND OF W.N.GANN CONSTABLE OF PREC NO ONE

On this the 12th day of October 1925, came on to be considered by the commissioners court the matter of approving the official bond of W.N.Gann Constable of Precinet N, One Titus County TEXAS. Motion by commissioner Cameron seconded by commissioner, Luns, that the bond executed by Mr Gann as principal and _____ as surety be approved and that the sureties on the bond executed by Mr Gann as principal and _____ and _____ sureties approved on the ___ day of 1925, be released, The County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote NO. all voted in the affirmative and the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING EARL DAVIS FOR FILLING DIPPING VATS.

On this the 14th day of Sept 1925, came on to be considered by the commissioners court at its regular Sept meeting the matter of paying Earl Davis \$7.50 for filling dipping vats. Commissioner _____ made a motion seconded by Commissioner Luns to pay the amount the county Judge put the motion before the body with the request that as many favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" Commissioner King and Commissioner Luns voted in the affirmative and Commissioner Lindsey voted in the negative, Commissioner _____ not voting. The County Judge delored the motion carried and the order passed.
