Cameron Lindsay, Luna; and King, all voted in the affirmative, and the County Judge, declared, the motion carried and the order passed.

IN MATTER OF APPOINTING JUSTICE OF PEACE OF WINFIELD.

On this the 9th, day of Nov. 1925, came on to be Considered, by the Commissioners, Court the matter of appointing, one to fill the vacancy caused by the death of H B Green J.P. Precinct No. 8. Titus County, Texas, On motion by Luna, seconded, by Cameron that F P Cox, be appointed, to fill said vacancy, the County Judge put the motion before the Court, with the request that all favored the motion to vote; in the affirmative and the County Judge, declared the motion carried, and the order passed.

IN MATTER OF ALLOWING FUNDS TO PRICE EXPENSES TO AUSTIN.

On this the 24th, day of October, 1925, came on to be considered, by the Commissioners, Court the matter of paying the expenses of Senator Lloyd Price to Austin for the purpose of obtaining, State aid for the construction of a new road; from Mt. Pleasant, to Pittsburg after ascertainment the amount of expense to be \$65.00 Commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner, Luna to allow the amount, above stated. the County Judge, put the motion before the Court, with the request that as many favored, the motion to voted, aye; and those opposed, to vote No. All members, Voted, in the affirmative, and the County Judge declared, the motion carried, and the order passed.

Meachum survey rendition for the unrendered and delinquent, 90 acre tract of land out of A. Personally appeared, J B Stephens, who being first duly sworn deposes and says;

My name is J B Stephens, and I am one of the joint owners of various, tracts, of land situated about 5 miles SW From Mt. Pleasant, Texas, among, them being, 90 acres, of land out of the A Wofford, headright, sur; and 1421 acres of the J Meachum headright, survey; the other joint owner being E S Lillienstern, and that I have charge of said land, and render same for taxation to the Tax Collector, of Titus County Texas.

During the year 1920 1921, 1922, 1923 and 1924, the 90 acres of land out of the Wofford sur; was not rendered except a 90 acre tract, out of said survey for the 1920, which was rendered, and said land appears, to be unrendered and delinquent, for the years, above set forth, except the year 1921, which shows the survey to be overrendered because of the fact that the Tax Assessor had 160 acres of Samuel Clark survey; belonging, to J R Barnett, rendered in the said Wofford, survey; That during, the years, 1920 1921, 1922, 1923, and 1924, there was rendered, to the Tax Assessor, and taxes paid on 1700 acres of land out of the J Meachum survey; Abstract, 356.

After leasing this Block of land for oil during the year, 192\_ having abstracts, brought up to date, I then discovered that I was not rendering, this land correctly that the said 90 acres of land out of the A. Wofford, survey was not being rendered and that there were not in fact, 1700 acres in the J Meachum survey; but by calculations of measurements, given it was ascertained that there were about 1421 acres of land in the said J Meachum sur; instead of 1700 acres.

in rendering this Block of land to the Tax, Assessor, we were suppose to have a certificate Number, of acres in the block and rendering it. I tries to render that number of acres and make the rendition full, and for some reason or other, the A Wofford, survey was, not mentioned, however, the numbers, of acres contained, in this survey; was included
