IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING ACCOUNTS.

On this the 14th day of December AD 1925 Commissioner Junes made a motion seconded by Commissioner King to allow all accounts as listed in Minutes of accounts allowed in Vol 2 pages _____ the County Judge put the Motion before the members of the court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote No. all voted AYE . the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE LATTER OF ISSUING CO. EVIDENCE OF CANCELLATION

On this the 14th day of December 1925, came on to be considered by the Commissioners court of Titus County, TEXAS the matter of authorizing the TAX collector of Titus County to issue a certificate showing that all taxes have been paid on 147 acres of the J.P. Box Survey located about 10 S 60 East from the town of Mt. Pleasant now owned by D.D. Taylor, and after ~~an~~ investigating, the matter and it appearing to the court that said land has heretofore been rendered for taxation and that all taxes have been paid but that said land has been rendered for taxation for 100 acres more or less, and that a recent survey shows that in fact there exists 147 acres of land. On Motion by Commissioner Cameron seconded by Commissioner Lindsey that the tax collector issue said certificate the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all Commissioners voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MANNER OF APPROVING TAX COLLECTOR'S REPORT

On this the 14th day of December AD 1925, Commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by commissioner King to approved Luther Taylor's report the county Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many favorer said motion vote vote "AYE and those oposed to Vote No. all commissioners Voted AYE the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF CANCELING PAUPER'S CHECK AND DISCONTINUING PAUPERISM

On this the 16th day of December 1926, came on to be considered by the Commissioner's Court of Titus County, TEXAS, the matter of taking Mrs Stephenson's name from the paupers roll after considering the matter and ascertaining the fact that she does not which any aid from the County through its pauper fund, and has failed to accept the check for \$12.50 heretofore issued to her commissioner Lindsay made a motion seconded by Emeron to strike her name from the pauper list and that the clerk be ordered not to issue any further warrants to her as a pauper, and that the warrant and check heretofore issued to her be cancelled. The County Judge put the motion before the body with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all members voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and it was passed.

IN THE MATTER OF REPAIRING COUNTY BARN.

On this the 14th day of December 1925, came on to be considered by the Court the matter of reparing the County Barn and after discussing the matter and it appearing to the court that the present barn is inadequate for the protection of the County's machinery and tools Commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by Commissioner Luns that the present barn be torn down and remodeled so as to be adequate to protect the County Machinery and tools The County Judge put the motion before the body with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all members voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
