 IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING FUND TO PAUPERS AND DISALLOWING FUNDS TO PAUPERS

On this the 11th day of January 1926 at it e regular January meeting came on to be considered by the Commissioner's court of Titus County, TEXA the matter of taking Rens Hall and the Old Negro Woman et Old's (Mollie Smith) off the pauper list Commissioner Cameron made a motionseconded by Commissioner King that the above named parties be striken from the list and that they receive no more allowance from the County as paupers, and that M.F.Dill be placed on the paupers roll with the allowance of \$15.00 for the percent month and \$7.50 ever month thereafter until the further order of this court The County Judge put the motion before the body with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to Vote "NO" Commissioners Cameron Lindsey King and Lane all voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

 IN THE MATTER OF PAYING GROCERY BILL OF DOUGLASS FAMILY

 IN THE MATTER OF ISSUING DUPLICATE SCRIPT TO TIMES REVIEW.

On this the 11th day of January 1926, came on to be considered by the Court the metter of issuing e duplicate warrant to G.W.Cross (Times Review Titus County TEXAS after it being made known to the court that G.W. Cross had heretofore issued to him e warrant on the General County fund for the sum of \$92.50 and that the same has been lost by Mr Cross and the same has never been paid, Commissioner Cameron made e motion seconded by Commissioner King that the said Cross be issued e duplicate warrant it is order that the County Clerk issued Warrant bearing the same number as the original and that same be paid according to the registration number placed on the original by the County treasurer The County Judge put the motion before the court with the request

On this the 11th day of January 1926 came on to be considered by the court the matter of approving the official bonds of the following officers G.P. Lindsey Commissioner of Precinct No. One W.K.
