Hon. E.L.Myers Judge, J.T.Cameron, W.M.King, A.J.Lane and C.P.Lindsey commissioners and W.E.McClintock, clerk of court with the following proceedings were had to wit

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING FUNDS TO PAUPERS

On this the 12th day of April AD 1926 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court the matter of granting aid to persons unable to work and provide for themselves After considering the matter and investigating the conditions of Ed Walker and M.C. Morrow commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by commissioner King that Ed Walker Colored be given \$5.00 a month and M.C.Morrow be given \$10.00 the County Judge the put the motion before the Court with the request that as many favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all commissioners being present and voted in the affirmative The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF REIMBURSING J.M.ELLIS FUNDS FOR CATTLE INSPECTING

On this the 12th day of April 1926 came on to be considered by the Commissioners court at its regular monthly meeting the matter of re-imbursing J.M.Ellie for the payment of One-half of the Titus County Cattle inspectors for the month of Oct 1925. After considering the matter and finding that the State did not begin the entire salaries of said inspectors until November 1st 1925, and that J.M.Ellie had paid the other half commissioner Lane made a motion seconded by Commissioner King that J.M.Ellie be re-imbursed out of the General County fund the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed. Said amount for the sum of \$75.00

IN THE MATTER OF BUYING NEW TRACTOR FOR TITUS COUNTY.

On this the 12th day of April AD 1926, the Commissioner's court at its regular monthly meeting came on to be considered the matter of buying a new tractor for the road work in Titus County. After discussing the matter of buying a new tractor and the condition of the Present One now used for said road purposes and ascertaining that it would cost several hundred dollars to repair the one now in use so that it would be serviceable Commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lane that the County Judge advertise for bids as required by law to be placed before the Court at its regular monthly meeting in May 1926..

IN THE MATTER OF GRANTING PUBLIC ROAD.

On this the 12th day of April 1926, came on to be considered by the Commissioners court the matter of granting a public road beginning at the Common Boundary line of C.W.Fleming and J.H.Booth on the Marshall springs road Thence South to the Polk Bridge road said road being petitioned by J.B.Kirk and seven other free holders along the route of the proposed road.. Commissioner Lane made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lindsey that said road be granted the county Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all commissioners being present and voted in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the road duly established..
