

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT THERE WAS BEGUN AND HELDEN A REGULAR TERM OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT  
OF TITUS COUNTY TEXAS ON THIS THE 10th day of May AD1926, with the following officers  
present to-wit: Hon . E.L.Myers Judge, Commissioners King, Luna , Cameron and Lindsey  
and W.E.McClintock, Clerk when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

**IN THE MATTER OF PURCHASING A NEW TRACTOR**

On this the 10th day of March came on to be considered the matter of purchasing a new tractor for the purpose of working the public Roads in Titus County. After considering the matter and considering the bids which have been advertised for the legal length of time Commissioner Luns made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lindsey that the court accept the bid of the R.E. George Machinery Co of Dallas, the bid having been accompanied by a cashier's check for the required amount .. Said bid offering to sell to the county one Caterpiller sixty tractor complete with 16 in track shoe canopy top and complete set of tools for the consideration of \$50.00 cash six one Thousand Dollars ,Titus County Road and Bridge Warrants maturing annually the first maturing on the 15th day of March 1927,  
and one on the 15th day of March each and every year thereafter up to and including March 15th 1932 with interest at the rate of 6% per annum and one second hand 5 ton Holt tractor.,  
the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative The County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF PURCHASING A NEW GRADER

On this the 10th day of May 1926, came on to be considered by the Commissioners court of Titus County, Texas the matter of purchasing a new grader for road work in Titus County, after considering the matter Commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by commissioner Luns to purchase a new Russell Grader with a 12 foot blade with a three foot attachment and that the old 9 foot grader be cut in for \$400.00 as part payment on the new grader, the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all commissioners being present and voted in the affirmative the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF SELLING FORDSON TO R.O.NICHOLSON

On this the 10th day of May 1926, came on to be considered by the Commissioner's court of Titus County Texas the matter of selling an old Fordson to R.G. Nicholson and after considering the matter and concluding that the further operation of said machine by the County is expensive and unsatisfactory, Commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lindsey that we sell said machine to R.G. Nicholson for the sum of \$225.00 and that he pay for it in bridge lumber at \$25.00 per thousand to be delivered during the year 1926, as called for by said court or either member of same. The County Judge put the motion before the body with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all members being present and voting in the affirmative the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF ADVANCING MONEY TO COUNTY CLERK TO BY STAMPS

On this the 10th day of May 1926 came on to be considered by the Commissioners court the matter of paying W.E.McClintock for stamps used in sending out county Mail after considering the matter Commissioner Cameron made a motion that he be allowed \$5.00 to buy stamps with The County Judge put the motion before the body with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and three opposed to vote No.

all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

**IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING ACCOUNTS.**

On this the 10th day of May A.D. 1986, Commissioner Luna made a motion seconded by commissioner Cameron to allow all accounts as listed in minutes of accounts allowed in Vol 4 pg 226 pgs. The County Judge put the motion before the body with the request that all my favored said motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote NO. all Commissioners voted AYE, the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

The above and foregoing minutes read and approved in open court this the 10th day of May AD1926..
