On this the 11th day of Ootober AD 1935 came on to be considered the matter of approving seports Commissioner Luna made a motion seconded by commissioner King to approve reports of Tax Collector Luther Taylor County Clark W.E.McClintook , District Clark W.E.Whitaker, Sheriff Sam Hees Justice of Peace J.P.Wilkinson County Attorney Same Williams County Twessurer G.B.Diokson Constable W.E.Gann , Justice of Peace R.A.Jawler Justice of the Peace R.S.Ywens, the County Judge put the motion before the members of the Sourt with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AXE and those opposed to vote "MO" all voted in the affirmative the county Judge declared the matter metion carried that the order passed.
