IN THE MATTER OF PAYING RUND TO PAUPERS

On this the 8th day of November AD1927 came on to be considered by the Commissioners court of Titus County Texas the request of Mollie Treylor and I.H.Hill and Gus Rutherford, to be placed on the pauper list of the County after considering the matter and ascertaining the fact that ~~that~~ all of said parties are unable to work and in destitute circumstances Commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lune that said parties be placed on the pauper list and that Mollie Treylor be paid \$5.00 per month and that I.H.Hill be paid \$7.50 per month and that Gus Rutherford be paid \$5.00 per month the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote Aye and those opposed to vote No. All members being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF LAVING WATER MAIN ON THE SQUARE.

On this the 8th day of November 1926 came on to be considered by the Commissioners court the matter of permitting the city of Mt.Pleasant to place its water main just inside the curb on the square, and Commissioner Cameron made the following motion seconded by Commissioner Lune; That the City of Mt.Pleasant be permitted to place its water mains just inside the curb on the east, South and West sides of the square with the understanding that the ditch where the main is put is filled and the surface of the ground be put back in as good condition as before the main is put on said square

IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING ACCOUNTS.

On this the 8th day of Nov. AD1926 Came on to be considered the matter of allowing accounts Commissioner King made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lune that all accounts be allowed as listed in minutes of accounts allowed in Vol 4 page _____. The county judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO. All voted Aye the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
