On this the 13th day of Die 192y came on to be considered the mat er of paying Willie Bynum money for maintenance, and after considering the matter and ascertaining the facts that said Willie Bynum is and has been his entire an idiot and is without any property or anyone to care for him commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner Luna that the said Willie Bynum be allowed \$10.00 a month out off the paper fund of Titus County, the County Judge put the motion before the body with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYX and those opposed to vote NO all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 13th day of Dec 1920 came on to be considered by the Commissioners court of Titus County Texas the matter of furnishing fuel at the county Jail, Commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lindsey that hereafter the County will pay not to exceed \$8.00 per cord for stove wood used at said sail the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote 80 all members of the court being present and voting in the affirmative the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 13th day of Dec. 1926 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court the resignation of J.B.Bonds, constable of Prec Bo 3 Titue County Texas when Commissioner Aing made amotion seconded by commissioner Luna that said resignation be accepted the county Judge put the motion before the court with the request that se many as favored the motion to vote AYS and those proposed to vote BO all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

On this the 15th day of Dec 192y came on to be considered by the Commissioners Goart the matter of resmbursing J.W. Vanhouse the sum of \$48 \$4.75 sexxests paid into the County Treasurer on account of the sale of One of the said Vanhouse's cows sold under and by the provisions of the stock law of fexas, after considering the matter and sacertaining theat the cow sold belonged to the said Vanhouse and that he has claimed same. Commassioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner Luna that Mr Vanhouse be allowed the amount specified the County Judge put the motion before the body with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AVE and those opposed to vote NO. All commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING LUTHER TAYLOR'S REPORT TAX COLLECTOR.

On this the 13th day of Dec 1922 came on to be considered the monthly report of Luther Taylor Tax Collector of Titus County. Taxes after checking and examining the same and ascertaining that it is in due form and correct Commissioner Cameron made a motion accorded by Commissioner Lindsay that said report be approved the county Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote No all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the county Judge declared the motion carried and the report approved.
