

BE IT REMEMBERED ^{there} that was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioners Court in and for Titus County Texas, on this 13th day of December A.D. 1926 with the following officers present to-wit: Hon. K.L.Myers, A.J.Luna, J.T.Cameron, C.P.Lindsey and W.M.King, all Commissioners, when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF LIGHT TESTING STATION.

On this the 13th day of Dec. 1926 came on to be considered by the commissioners court of Titus County Texas at its regular monthly meeting the matter of designating an official motor vehicle light testing station at Winfield, Texas and it appearing to the court that G.W.Grissom has heretofore been the official tester for Winfield, but is no longer in the garage business there when Commissioner Luna made a motion seconded by commissioner King that G.W.Smith hereafter be official tester for said lights on condition that he make a bond approvable by this court the county Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote No all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the county declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF WILLIE BYNUM PAUPER.

On this the 13th day of Dec 1926 came on to be considered the matter of paying Willie Bynum money for maintenance, and after considering the matter and ascertaining the facts that said Willie Bynum is and has been his entire an idiot and is without any property or anyone to care for him commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner Luna that the said Willie Bynum be allowed \$10.00 a month out of the pauper fund of Titus County, the County Judge put the motion before the body with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF FURNISHING FUEL TO THE COUNTY JAIL.

On this the 13th day of Dec 1926 came on to be considered by the Commissioners court of Titus County Texas the matter of furnishing fuel at the county Jail, Commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lindsey that hereafter the County will pay not to exceed \$8.00 per cord for stove wood used at said Jail the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO all members of the court being present and voting in the affirmative the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF RESIGNATION of J.B.Bonds constable Prec No. 3.

On this the 13th day of Dec. 1926 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court the resignation of J.B.Bonds, constable of Prec No 3 Titus County Texas when Commissioner King made a motion seconded by commissioner Luna that said resignation be accepted the county Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
