IN THE MATTER OF COUNTY OFFICIAL QUALIFYING FOR THE next two years.

On this the 1st day of January 1927 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County the matter of ~~approving~~ approving official bonds. Commissioner Cameron made a motion seconded by Commissioner King that all bonds be approved, of the various officers as recorded in the official bond register of Titus County for the years 1927 and 1928. The County Judge put the Motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored said motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO. All voted AYE, the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
