

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioner Court in and for Titus County Texas on this the 14th day of FEB AD 1927, when the following officer present to-wit Hon. E.L.Myers Judge , C.P.Lindsey L.H.Old, A.J.Lane and W.M.King all commissioners and W.E.McClintock, Clerk when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

IN THE MATTER COUNTY HOME DEMONSTRATION WORK AND COUNTY AGENT WORK.

On this the 14th day of Feb AD1927, came on to be considered by the Commissioner court of Titus County Texas in the matter of Corporation with the A and M.College of Texas, in carrying on, the home demietration work and County Farm Agent work, by the Commissioner court of Titus, County TEXAS, after considering the matter, and ascertaining that said work is beneficial for the well fere of Titus County, Commissioner Lane, made a motion seconded by Commissioner King, that Titus County appropriate, \$1000.00 for each of said agents out of the General fund of Titus County TEXAS, said Thousand Dollars payable in equal monthly instalments, the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO. Commissioners Lane and King, voted in the affirmative, Commissioners Old and Lindsey voted in the negative, the County Judge voted in the affirm stive, the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF TITUS, Commissioners Court of Titus County in session FEBRUARY Term AD 1927 the Commissioners Court of Titus County being desirous of promoting a more profitable method of agriculture and of assisting in the development of more comfortable and convenient rural homes in the county if othe opinion that a County Agent shou'd be employed to assist in said work, and in as much as the U.S.Department of Arriiculture, through the extension Service of the A. and M.College of Texas, will conduct Extension Work in this County provided the Commissioners' Court of the County will cooperate financially, the court is of the opinion that it should make an appropriation to supplement the funds of the Extension Service of the A. and M.College of Texas in conducting such work in accordance with the general laws of Texas,.

It is, therefore, ordered by this court that the sum of \$1000.00 be appropriated and the same is hereby appropriated out of the funds whiffism of General County to assist in promotink a better method of agricultrre and the levelppment of more comfortable and convenient rural homes in Titus County,.

This appropriation shall become available on FEB 1st 1927 or as soon thereafter as the extension Service of the A. and M.College of Texa. shall place an agent in said County for duty, and shall be paid out in monthly installments to said agent upon written order duly signed by an authorized representative of said extension Service.

It is understood that this appropriation shall be continuous until the Commis ioners Court or the extension Service of the A. and M.Co llege of Texas, shall decide to discontinue same but before either party shall discontinue same at least 30 days written notice shall be given the other party of the intention to so discontinue, unless other agreed upon by the commissioners Court and an authorized agent of the Extension servise

IN THE MATTER OF RECEIVING COUNTY DEPOSITORY..

On this the 14th day of February AD1927 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus county Texas, the matter of selecting county depository for the succeeding two years, after examining the bids, ascertaining that the First National Bank of Mt. Pleasant Texas, was the sole and only bidder, for County Funds, and that said bid, be accompanied by the Cashier Check, for \$1200.00 the same being not less than 1/2 of 1 per cent, of the County funds, for the proceeding year and that said bid offering pay 5 per cent on daily balances, Commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by Commissioner King to except said bid of the First National Bank of Mt. Pleasant, Texas as county depository upon the presentation and the approval ~~xxxx~~ by the Commissioner court of Titus County Texas, of a legal bond executed by said Bank, of the sum of \$134, the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many favored said motion to vote AYe and all opposed to vote NO. all voted in the affirmative.. the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER

On this the 14th day of Feb AD 1927, came on to be considered the matter of selecting County Health officer for Titus County, for the next succeeding year Commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by commissioner Old that Dr S.R.Crebtrees be appointed county Health officer for the next year the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many favored said motion to vote AYe, all opposed to vote No. all voted in the affirmative, the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed..

IN THE MATTER OF ADVANCING MONEY TO PAUPERS

On this the 14th day of FEB AD 1927 came on to be considered by the commissioners court of Titus County Texas the matter of advancing money to Gus Rutherford increase his pay from \$5.00 to \$7.50 per month and also to allow Mrs Mays Conroy \$7.50 per month and also to allow C.S.Bleck \$10.00 the County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many favored said motion to vote AYe and all opposed to vote NO, all vote in the affirmative the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed..

IN THE MATTER OF TAX LEVY FOR THE YEAR 1927

On this the 14th day of FEB AD 1927 came on to be considered, by the commissioners court of Titus County Texas, with the following officers present to-wit E.L.Myers County Judge and presiding, Commissioners Lane, ~~xxxx~~ Old, Lindsey and W.M.King all present, ~~xxxx~~ the matter, of levying taxes for the year 1927, on real and personal property of Titus County Texas, when commissioner Lindsey, made a motion seconded by commissioner Old, that the tax levy be as follows, on the \$100.00 valuation of real and personal property of Titus County Texas..

- For Principal and Interest refunding and interest Road and Bridge Indebtedness . . . . . \$ .14

- for Jgry purposes, . . . . . \$ .15

The County Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many favored said motion to vote AYe and those opposed to vote No. all voted in the affirmative the county Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
