

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT there was begun and held a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, on this the 11th day of July AD 1927 with the following officers present to wit: E.L. Myers Judge Commissioners King, Lana, Lindsey and Old when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING THE SHERIFF Sixty Five Cents per day for Boarding Prisoners: On this the 11th day of July at its regular monthly meeting came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, with all members, the matter of paying the Sheriff for Boarding the County Prisoners. After discussing the matter Commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lana that the Sheriff be allowed sixty five cents per day for each prisoner while in Jail. The County Judge put the motion before Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO, Commissioners Lindsey Lana, and King voted in the affirmative, commissioner Old voted in the negative and the County judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING MRS. WILLIAMS \$25.00 out of the Pauper Fund In this the 11th day of July 1927, came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court the matter of allowing Mrs. Williams, a sum of money out of the paupers fund, After discussing the matter and ascertaining that she is in destitute circumstances, and is in need of medical care and treatment and is without either property or funds to care for herself, commissioner King made a motion seconded by Commissioner Lana that she be allowed \$25.00 out of the paupers fund, the county Judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO All commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF PAYING J.H. HERREN A MONTHLY ALLOWANCE OUT OF THE PAUPERS FUND \$10.00 On this the 11th day of July 1927, came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of making to J.H. Herren a monthly allowance out of the paupers fund. After discussing the matter and ascertaining the facts that he is unable to work and without either property or funds commissioner King made a motion seconded by commissioner Lana that he be allowed \$10.00 out of the paupers fund, the County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO, all commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

IN THE MATTER OF PURCHASING SCHOOL BONDS OF COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 30. Titus Co. Tex. On this the 11th day of July 1927, came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of purchasing School House Bonds of Common School District No. 30 Titus County, Texas, each bond for the principal sum of \$100.00 bearing date of Nov 10th 1919, and being numbered from 17 to 20 both inclusive. After considering the matter and ascertaining the fact that the county has sufficient amount of money in the permanent school fund not invested commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by Commissioner Old that said bonds be purchased with the permanent school fund of Titus County Texas county Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO. All the members of the Court being present and voting in the affirmative the County judge declared the motion carried.
