

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT there was begun and holden a regular term of the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, on this the 8th day of August AD 1927 with the following officers present to-wit E.L. Myers Judge Commissioners King, Luna Lindsey and Old & W.E. McClintock Clerk when the following proceedings were had to-wit:

 IN THE MATTER OF PAYING W.A. CRANE A MONTHLY ALLOWANCE OF \$10.00 out of the Pauper Fund,

On this the 8th day of August 1927, at its regular monthly meeting with all members present came on to be considered by the commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas, the matter of paying W.A. Crane a monthly allowance as pauper. After considering the matter and ascertaining that the said W.A. Crane is above seventy years old and physically unfit to do any kind of work and that he is in destitute circumstances, commissioner Old made a motion seconded by commissioner King that the said W.A. Crane be allowed \$10.00 a month as pauper out of the county pauper fund. The County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO. Commissioner Old, King and Lindsey voted in the affirmative, commissioner Luna not being present, the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

 IN THE MATTER OF THE MONTHLY REPORT OF LUTHER TAYLOR TAX COLLECTOR OF TITUS COUNTY TEXAS.

On this the 8th day of August came on to be considered and examined the monthly report of tax collector Luther Taylor, after examining the same and ascertaining the fact that same is correct and in every way conforms to law relating to reports of tax collectors, commissioner Lindsey made a motion seconded by commissioner Old that that said report be approved. The County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO all members having been present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

 IN THE MATTER OF W.M. KING REPORT

On this the 8th day of August came on to be considered the report of W.M. King Justice of the peace of Pre. No. 3, Titus County Texas, after examining same and ascertaining that it in every way conforms, to the requirements of law the County judge put the motion before the court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO all members being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.

 IN THE MATTER OF ALLOWING COUNTY JUDGE E.L. MYERS EXPENSES FOR INSPECTING ROADS & Bridges.

On this the 8th day of August AD 1927 came on to be considered the matter of allowing County judge E.L. Myers expenses for inspecting roads and bridges after considering the matter and ascertaining that he has been to a great amount of expense in said work for which expense he has not been re-imbursed or paid, and ascertaining further that the said County judge has collected through error for heretofore holding commissioners Court Commissioner Old made a motion seconded by Commissioner Luna that county judge E.L. Myers be paid for the above mentioned expenses the sum of heretofore collected by him through error for holding commissioners Court. The County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that those who favored said motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO all present and voting in the affirmative to County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
