 IN THE MATTER OF PAYING FOR GROCERIES FURNISHED TO CARE FOR EFFIE WHITE WHILE WAITING FOR  
 An opening in the Insane Asylum.

On this the 10th day of Oct AD 1927 came on to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Titus County Texas, the matter of paying for groceries, furnished to Care for Effie White While waiting for an opening, in the insane Asylum after considering, the matter and ascertaining that the said Effie White was adjudged insane by the County Court of Titus County, Texas, and at the time she was adjudged to be insane she could not be placed in the asylum, and that her physical condition was such that she could not be properly cared for in the County Jail, and that the County had no other place for her safe keeping, and that her father cared for and guarded her until she could be sent to the asylum, and that neither she nor her father had any property and were unable to procure the proper food for her to eat and that said groceries, were purchased from Jones Grocery for her benefit On motion by Commissioner Lindsey seconded by Commissioner King that said amount of \$11.00 be paid out of the pauper fund of the County the County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote "AYE" and those opposed to vote "NO" all Commissioners voted in the affirmative and the County Judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
