All commissioners being present and voting in the affirmative the County Judge declared the order passed.

Crigler be paid the sum of \$500.00 out of the Court House and Jail, fund, the County Judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote NO" all commissioners present voted in the affirmative and the County judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
