After investigating the Circumstances of both and ascertaining that they are unable to work and own no property and are in destitute circumstances, Commissioner Olds made a motion seconded by Commissioner Luna that each be allowed \$7.00 a month out of the pauper fund, the County judge put the motion before the Court with the request that as many as favored the motion to vote AYE and those opposed to vote No, all members of the Court being present and voting in the affirmative the county judge declared the motion carried and the order passed.
